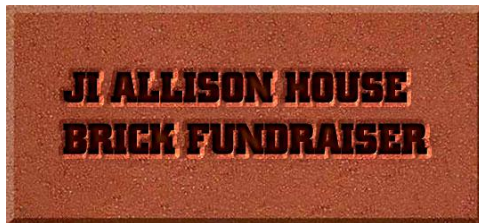
## HOLLY CENTER

### JI Allison House Engraved Brick or Tile

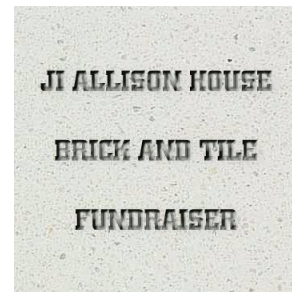
Originally located at 2215 6<sup>th</sup> Street, this house was restored to commemorate the writing of Buddy Holly and The Crickets music, including the hit song "That'll Be The Day" in 1956. Inspired by a line from the John Wayne movie *The Searchers*, Buddy and J.I. (original founding members of the Crickets) penned the song in this home. The song neared the top of the Billboard charts in September of 1957.
